SCHEDULE

GAME LENGTH

U9 - U10 will play 2 X 25 minutes (50 minute game)

U11 - U13 will play 2 x 30 minute (60 minute game)

All games will have a 5 minute half time.

All games must start exactly on time to maintain the tournament schedule. Failure to start the game on time may require the game length to be reduced accordingly.

GAME FORMAT

U9 - U10 = 7 v 7 (6 + GK)

U11 - U12 = 8 v 8 (7 + GK)

U13 - 9 v 9 = (8 + GK)

Limited warm up time on the field before each game. Teams need to use the casual field space at the park. Note - leave ample time to get to your game field so that kick-off can be on time

GAME SHEETS & SCORE REPORTING

Teams do not need to print game sheets or report scores. As per Canada Soccer's Long Term Player Development Model scores are not kept in U13 and under games.

HEADQUARTERS TENT

If you need anything during the event the quickest way to get in touch with us is through the HQ tent.

CHECKING IN

Teams do not need to check in, all information should be uploaded to your dashboard before the event. Teams do not need to show Player ID cards at each game. Please have proof of age available for all players in case you are asked by a tournament official at any of your games.

REFEREE

If your referee is not at the field 5 minutes before the start of your game, please visit HQ and let us know.

TOURNAMENT STAFF

Field Marshalls can be found through-out the parks. If you can't find a Field Marshall go to the park headquarters there will always be someone there who can help you.

EVENT APPAREL

Pre-ordered Apparel will be available for pickup at the Headquarters at your park. If you did not pre-order check with the HQ to see what is available for sale at your park.



FIRST AID/ATHLETIC THERAPIST



First Aid/Athletic Therapists will be on site at Cloverdale Athletic Park & Newton Athletic Park for minor injuries and taping (where time permits).
 Players must either supply their own tape or pay a nominal fee to the Athletic Therapist.

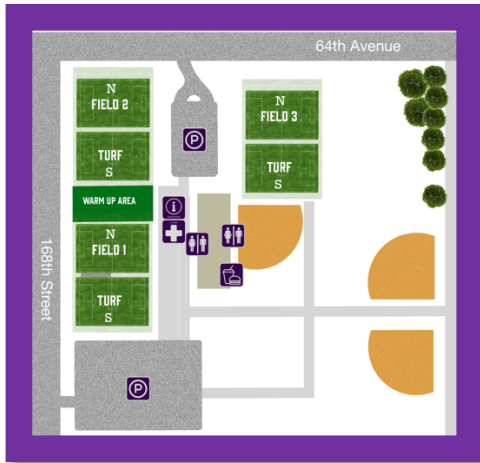
IF THERE IS AN INJURY ON YOUR FIELD?

HJORTH ROAD PARK

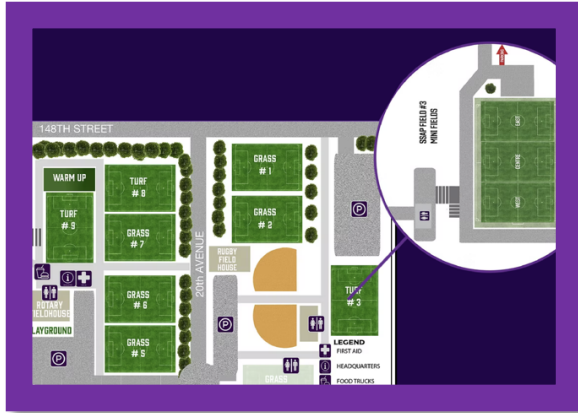
10275 148th Street, Surrey

- Hjorth Road Park has 4 small sided turf fields
- The Headquarters tent is between the two fields.
- Apparel pre-orders can be picked up at Headquarters
- Kona Ice will be onsite all weekend



SOUTH SURREY ATHELTIC PARK

14600 20th Ave, Surrey



- Turf field 3 has 3 small sided fields. East (closest to 148th street) Centre, West (closest to the stairs up to the baseball diamonds)
- Parking off 148th right before Semiahmoo Secondary School
- There will be staff to help you find your field
- Headquarters for SSAP is across 20th Avenue near field #9.
- Pre-sales for Apparel can be picked up there.
- First Aid will be by Field #9
- Food trucks will be available by Field #9



NEWTON ATHELTIC PARK

- All fields are turf
- Overflow parking is available across the street at the school
- DO NOT park on curbs or block entrance into the park.
- Headquarters, First Aid & Food Trucks will be next to Field 5 in the centre concourse area

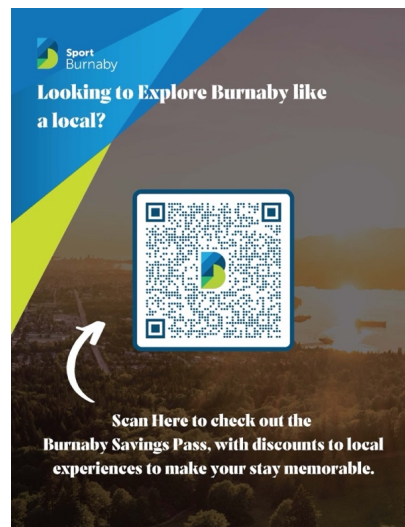

DISCIPLINE

Any player/coach receiving a red card in a match is subject to discipline as follows:

- An automatic suspension for his/her next game
- Potential further review/suspension by the discipline committee

The referee's decision in matters concerning the Laws of the Game is considered final.

The Tournament Officials will not overrule a referee's decision.

PROTESTS

Only protests regarding non-referee decisions will be permitted.

All protests will only be entertained if received, in writing, within one hour of the completion of the game in question. A \$250 fee, payable in cash must accompany all protests. Protests and fees can be delivered to the tournament headquarters. The protest fee will be fully refunded if the protest in question is deemed valid.

GRIEVANCES

The following process has been implemented to address any complaints or issues that arise throughout the event.

- Grievances must only be reported by Team Managers by email to the Tournament Directors grievances@premiersoccerseries.com
- Any reports from anyone other than a team official will be deleted upon receipt.
- Provide a clear written account of the incident including - game number, time and location plus name(s) of persons involved.

A Tournament Official will respond to the grievance.

- All reports will be addressed in order of severity.
- All reports will be taken seriously; but not all will warrant further investigation.
- Some reports may not be addressed until after the event if they do not affect the outcome/running of the event.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION



Please keep in mind that the spirit of this event, for all levels, is to have fun and compete against other teams of similar ability. We understand that everyone likes to win; however, in the process, we expect that all teams respect their opponents, the match officials and tournament staff.



The Premier Spring Showcase has a zero-tolerance policy for verbal and/or physical abuse of any referee by players, team officials, parents or spectators and will take any infraction seriously (potential suspension for entire event or team expulsion from the tournament)

Players, coaches, and spectators are expected to conduct themselves within the Laws of the Game and generally accepted good sportsmanship. Displays of temper or dissent are cause for ejection from the game and surrounding field area. Repeated violations may result in the suspension/expulsion of the team in question.

It is the responsibility of the Club/Team staff to control the conduct of its parents and other spectators. Failure to do so may result in a warning to the coach or person acting on the coach's behalf. If unacceptable behaviour persists, the referee may terminate the match.

All participants should be aware that Field Marshals have the authority and right to remove any unruly or uncivil spectators from the game field perimeter and/or the field complex area.

Absolutely no alcoholic beverages are permitted in the park.
